CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order at 3:30 p.m. by Mr. Krelis.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: On a motion by Mr. Hall, with a second by Mr. Renzella, the Board approved the minutes of the January 19, 2011, meeting.

CORRESPONDENCE:

<u>PRI Discussion</u> – The PRI will be held on April 12, 2011 and April 13, 2011 at the White Palace, Wheeling Park. Lydotta McClure Taylor will be the presenter and it will center around 21st Century Life Skills (Enclosure).

<u>IPI Review</u> (Attachment A) – Mrs. Kajfez provided the Board with Attachment A which is a list of instructional practice inventory trainings and dates for each of the counties.

Medicaid Report (Attachment B) - On a motion by Mr. Jorden, with a second by Ms. Smith, the Board approved the February 1, 2011, Medicaid Report prepared by Mrs. Wojcik in the aggregated amount of \$2,967,459.36 (from 7/1/10 through 1/31/11 for the RESA-6 counties.

<u>Legislative Update</u> – Mr. Zervos requested the support of the Board Members for HB 3069 which removes the cap from RESA funding. He provided them with copies of the bill and a legislative packet of contacts.

Other handouts provided the status of the Education Job Funding (SB 255). Also, a news release regarding teacher evaluation, a copy of the deadlines for legislative action and a news release indicating West Virginia had a \$241,000,000 surplus thus far in the 2010 –

2011 service year (enclosure).

<u>RESA-6 Interview – Channel 14</u> – The Board was informed that Mr. Zervos was interviewed by West Liberty University television channel 14. The topic was a review of RESAs and what they provide to county school districts (enclosure).

<u>RESA System of Support Discussion</u> – Mr. Minnich and Mr. Zervos discussed a regional system of support for the 5 counties utilizing retirees who have expertise needed to support programs and services in RESA-6 counties. Mr. Minnich was requested to bring a written proposal back to the Board.

<u>2011 – 2012 Personnel Change Request</u> – Mr. Zervos requested any needed personnel changes that the counties recommend prior to the March Board Meeting.

Smart Find Express – Mrs. Kouski provided the Board with a handout outlining the SmartFind Express Substitute Calling System. Several superintendents gave a testimonial regarding their pleasure and successes with the system. A half year notice is necessary for a new county to come on board so that appropriate training and information can be collected. Mr. Minnich will bring back a financial proposal which includes Brooke County.
